## RESOLUTION # 12-28-04-03

WHEREAS: Kossuth County has proposed secondary road paving projects scheduled as follows:

**PROJECT L-P602--73-55** This 2.0 mile project is the paving of road B40 (210<sup>th</sup> Street) running on the north line of Sections 10-95-27 and 11-95-27, Prairie Township. The project begins at 220<sup>th</sup> Avenue and ends at R14 (240<sup>th</sup> Avenue).

**PROJECT L-P108--73-55** This 3.5 mile project is the paving of road P44 (130<sup>th</sup> and 125<sup>th</sup> Avenues) beginning at the northwest corner of section 7-97-28, Portland Township, thence running north 1.5 miles north to the west quarter corner of section 31-98-28, Ramsey Township, thence running west 0.5 miles to the center of section 36-98-29, Greenwood Township thence running 1.5 miles north to the north quarter corner of section 25 -98-29, Greenwood Township. The project begins at B14 (330<sup>th</sup> Street) and ends at A42 (360<sup>th</sup> Street).

WHEREAS; the projects are included in Kossuth County's five year program and,

WHEREAS; Kossuth County is required to conduct a public hearing since the projects do not meet the required point system for paving and,

WHEREAS; proper legal notice and publication of the public hearing has been served and,

WHEREAS; the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors has held a public hearing regarding the proposed paving projects, and

WHEREAS, no objections were received either in writing or by people present, and

WHEREAS, support was received from people present:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors that the projects be developed by the Kossuth County Engineer for construction of the paving as programmed.
