THIRTY-FIRST DAY JULY 1, 2003

### **REGULAR JULY SESSION**

The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment. Present were: Don McGregor, Chairman, Eugene Elsbecker, Bob Cink, Don Besch and Lee Froehlich. Absent: none.

Motion by Besch and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Froehlich to move the approval of payroll and claims until 11:10 a.m. Ayes: all Nays: none. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion by Cink and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Elsbecker to approve minutes of previous meeting as read. Ayes: all Nays: none. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion by Besch and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cink to approve the agenda with change in time for claims. Ayes: all Nays: none. Motion carried unanimous.

Public Discussion and Committee Reports:

Don Besch reported on 28E Agreement on HIPAA and was told it would cost \$8400 for each county up front.

Don McGregor reported on a spill and a call to the DNR in the north end of county.

A letter from Stein Law Office LLP was handed out to each supervisor for them to read.

Web Orton and the Supervisors discussed containment of creek water and how to try to control the flow from flooding. They will walk the area and take a look at it.

Motion by Elsbecker and 2<sup>nd</sup> by McGregor to approve fireworks for location being Section 36, T-97N R-29W. Ayes: all Nays: none. Motion carried unanimous.

A discussion was held with the Sheriff and a pick-up was purchased – a Ford F-150 Super Crew with topper. This will be used for lab equipment. Sheriff received 21 bullet proof vest from Grant, however we must pay 50% of funds, we will have 3 to 4 years to use money. At the present time, there are 20 people in the jail today.

WHEREAS, it is desired to make appropriations for each of the different officers and departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, in accordance with session 331.434 sub section 6, Code of Iowa at 100% of the total budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Kossuth County, Iowa as follows:

### Section 1:

The amounts itemized by fund and be department or office on the attached schedule are hereby appropriated for the resources of each fund so itemized, to the department or office listed in the first column on the same line of the attached schedule.

### Section 2:

Subject to the provision of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the appropriations authorized under Section 1 shall constitute authorization for the department or officer listed to make expenditures or incur obligations from itemized fund, effective July 1, 2003.

### Section 3:

In accordance with section 331.437 Code of Iowa, no department or officer shall expand or contract to expend any money or incur any liability, or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amounts appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

### Section 4:

If at any time during the Fiscal 03-04 budget year the Auditor shall as certain that the available resources of a fund for that year will be less than said fund's total appropriations, she shall immediately so inform the Board and recommend appropriate corrective action.

### Section 5:

The Auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in Section 1, each of which shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amounts charged thereto, and the unencumbered balance. The Auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable department and officer Quarterly, or sooner as needed during the 03-04 fiscal budget year.

### Section 6:

All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business June 30, 2004.

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the Auditor to periodically transfer sums from the general basic and rural services basic funds to the secondary road fund during the 03-04 fiscal budget year, and

WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with section 331.342, Code of Iowa,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Kossuth County, Iowa as follows:

### Section 1:

The total maximum transfer from the general basic fund to the secondary road fund for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003 shall not exceed the sum of 155,218 and the total maximum transfer from the rural services basic fund to the secondary road fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003 shall not exceed the sum of 1,914,782.

### Section 2:

Within 3-10 days of being notified of the apportionment of current property taxes, state replacements against levied property taxes, mobile home taxes, military service tax credit replacements, or livestock credit replacements to the general basic or rural services basic funds, the Auditor shall order a transfer from said fund to the Secondary road.

### Section 3:

The amount of the transfer required by Section 2 shall be equal to the apportionment made under Section 2 to the general basic or rural services basic fund, respectively, multiplied by the ratio of said funds total maximum transfer to the secondary road fund, to the sum of said funds total current property tax levy, total mobile home taxes, total military service tax credit replacements, and total livestock credit replacements.

#### Section 4:

Not withstanding the provisions of sections 2-7-3 of this resolution, total transfers to the secondary road fund shall not exceed the amounts specified in Section.

#### Section 5:

Not withstanding the provisions of section 2 and 3, the amount of any transfer shall not exceed available fund balances in the transferring fund.

### Section 6:

The Auditor is directed to correct her books when said operating transfers are made and to notify the treasurer and county engineer of the amounts of said transfers.
