The Board of Supervisors acknowledged transfers that were made by Kossuth County Auditor Amber Garman on November 7, 2012. The transfers included a transfer from the General Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund in the amount of \$34,983.78 and a transfer from the Rural Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund in the amount of \$400,035.63.

Motion by McGregor and 2nd by Besch that the Board of Supervisors of Kossuth County, Iowa, does hereby authorize and give its permission to Lone Rock Coop Telephone, Lone Rock, IA, in install new phone cable in the road right of way. Work will begin in the east right of way of 40th Avenue, approximately 550' north of the intersection of 40th Avenue and 260th Street. Then will cross 40th Avenue and plow south to the north shoulder of 260th Street, then continuing west approximately 1,800' to hog confinement site. Work will be in Section 10 and 9 Lotts Creek Township. Permit number 11-36-2012 is on file in the Kossuth County Engineer's Office. Motion carried.
