WHEN: Saturday, May 3, 2014 from 8:00 a.m. to noon.

WHERE: The Kossuth County Transfer Station-formerly the landfill

WHO: Residents living in the Kossuth Waste Management Association Service Area.

WHAT: A day to safely dispose of your household hazardous waste, recyclables, appliances and electronic waste.

In an effort to provide service to residents, the Kossuth County Transfer Station will be open Saturday morning, May 3rd for recycling, household hazardous waste and disposal of appliances and electronic waste only.

By appointment residents can properly dispose of their household hazardous waste at no cost. No farm chemicals or hazardous waste from a commercial customer will be accepted. Call the transfer station at 515-924-3739 to make an appointment for Saturday.

An appointment is not necessary to take your recyclables, appliances or electronic waste to the transfer station. A fee will be charged for appliances and electronic waste:

Appliances:	\$15.00/each
Computer Monitors	\$15.00/each
CPU/small electronic appliance	\$ 5.00/each
Keyboards/mice, small radios/phones	free
Televisions	
19" or smaller	\$15.00/each
Larger than 19"	\$20.00/each
Large console<100#'s	\$25.00/each
Larger mainframes/copiers, scanners, etc. >100 #'s	\$ 0.35/per pound



No garbage will be accepted on this Saturday, as the transfer station is not regularly open on Saturdays. This will be a great opportunity to get your spring cleaning done and properly dispose of the items on a Saturday!
